

The American Inclination of Synthesis: Studies in American Culture in the Twentieth Century.

The course will introduce the following writers and materials but will not consider them in equal detail. The student taking part will create the studies programme he requires from a combination of the lecture-seminars, his own written work and his particular readings. The subject of the course is a proposition for which these writers and materials are to be considered as evidence to be used in ways which seem appropriate. The proposition is that there is something particularly American in the urge to unify a large range of materials and energy into some kind of order, frequently on a epic scale and usually as if it were being carried through for the first time.
